• IMPORTANT ITEMS:

- If over the age of 16, you **must** bring your valid PA fishing license in order to participate.
- Weather-appropriate clothes/shoes – we suggest bringing sunscreen and rain gear.

• REGISTRATION INFO:

- Registration Site: Iroquois Boating & Fishing Club, 10733 Konneyaut Trail, Conneaut Lake, PA 16316
- Registration Time: **Please register by 6:00 a.m.** There will be a brief angler meeting at this time to go over tournament rules, etc. You will be paired with your assigned pro at this time.
 - Note: Your pro will provide all tackle and life jackets. You and your pro are required to wear your life jacket any time the gas combustion engine is running. You don't need to wear it while fishing or running the trolling motor. You may bring your own tackle and life jacket if you choose, but it is not necessary.
- Safety Acknowledgement – Liability Waiver and Release of Claims **must** be signed and submitted at registration table.

• EVENT INFO:

- **IF** you have registered and are unable to attend, please call (814) 337-1251 as soon as possible. This is critical information for the team-event.
 - A confirmation call will be made by the United Way to confirm your participation by Tuesday, July 19, 2022.
- A light continental breakfast and snack will be offered with bottled water at registration. You may also bring your own snacks or drinks if you choose.
- **Launch: promptly at 7:00 a.m (pending wake protocol – may be earlier)**
- All boats must clock in by 1:00 p.m. at the Iroquois Club dock. After you and your pro clock in, please refer to your team's directions for weigh-in protocol – distributed to pro prior to event.
 - You must accompany your pro to your pro's boat's launch site to put the boat on the trailer if you have more than 5 fish (just in case you get stopped by the Fish Commission). You may also dock at the Iroquois Club if space is available.
- Following the weigh-in (approximately 1:30 p.m.) lunch will be available.
