Eligibility

- Participants must be 15 years of age or under. (*Parent or legal guardian must be present for the duration of the event.)
- Participants must pre-registered with payment prior to event to secure slot. (*Limited slots available.)
- Participants must bring their own fishing equipment.

Fishing Rules

- Participants may bring multiple rods, but may only use one rod at a time.
- Artificial and live bait permitted.
- Catch and immediate release only.
- Parent/Guardian may assist only if they present a valid fishing license at check-in. [PA Fishing License Info](#)
- Limited event volunteers will be available to assist if needed.
- Space is encouraged between participants

Competition Categories

- Fish will be judged by length in the following categories:
 - Bass, Panfish, Other
- Ties will be broken by count

Measurement Process

- Fish must immediately be brought to event judges for official measurement and recording.
- Fish must be released immediately after measurement.
- All judge decisions are final.

Awards & Prizes

- Awards for Bass in each age category
- Additional certificates and prizes will be presented.

Code of Conduct

- Participants must uphold the highest level of sportsmanship, courtesy, safety, and conservation.
- Infractions of the rules may result in disqualification.
- Participants and guardians are expected to clean up all garbage. Garbage bags will be available.
